SASCC's free annual Health Fairs have been gathering community around health and wellness for many years, with hundreds of older adults and their families in attendance. Thanks to our community partners, each year we reach and serve an increasing number of people across the age spectrum in our community, thus expanding our vision of empowering communities to be great places to grow up and grow older.



RECENT SURVEY DATA SHOWS...

In partnership with the City of Saratoga, Town of Los Gatos, and West Valley-Mission Community College District, SASCC performed Community Assessment Surveys for Older Adults (CASOAs) in Los Gatos and Saratoga in 2022 and 2023.

Results showed that while older adults highly rate their quality of living in Saratoga and Los Gatos, there is much work to be done to meet the diverse needs of our aging population.

IN SARATOGA...

- 59% of older adults aren't aware of what resources are available to them
- 43% of older adults struggle to stay physically fit
- 27% of older adults feel lonely or isolated

• 29% of Saratoga older adults and 27% of Los Gatos older adults struggle to find work in retirement

- 57% of Saratoga older adults and 50% of Los Gatos older adults volunteer their time
- 36% of Saratoga older adults and 34% of Los Gatos older adults provide care to someone 55+
